**I.        PURPOSE**

A. The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance on the sale of fire district property as provisioned by section 176(23) of Town Law.

**II.       POLICY**

A. Section 176(23) of the Town Law states that if the value of the fire district property declared as surplus is less than \$10,000 the Board of Commissioners need to pass a resolution at a meeting declaring the item to be surplus and then dispose of it so as to maximize the return to the district. If the value of an item declared as surplus is over \$10,000. but less than \$50,000 the Board shall then publish a copy of the resolution within 10 days stating that it was adopted subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to section 6-g of the General Municipal Law. If resident taxpayers owning 25% of the residential real property within the district do not come forward with a petition within 30 days demanding a mandatory referendum the Board may dispose of the item obtaining the maximum value for the district. Lastly only if the item is valued over \$50,000. must the Board go forward with a mandatory referendum to the voters at a special election or at a regular Fire District election.
